*Much Ado About Nothing or Macbeth*

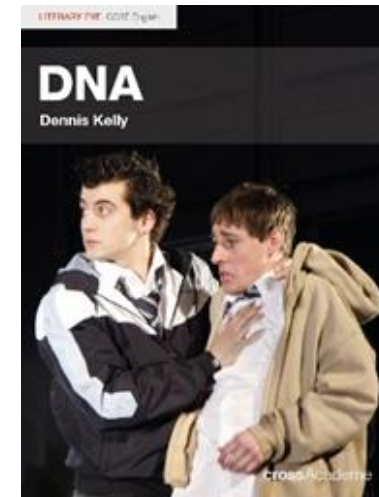
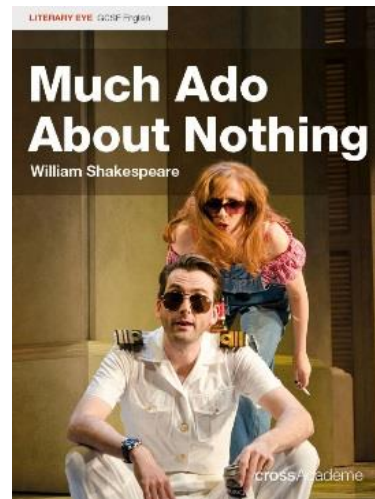
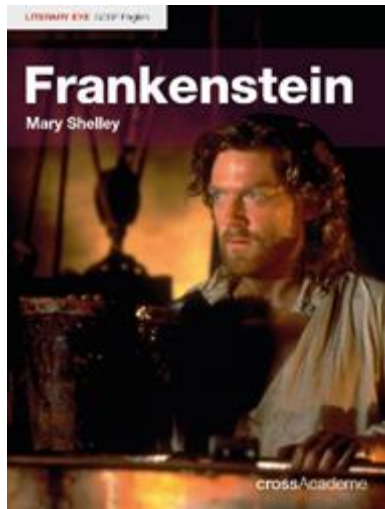
Read through and revise the 19<sup>th</sup> century novel they have also studied in lessons. Learn the quotations for either-
