Section 2, Page 6	..... C4 OTHER - C4 OTHER detentions are to be given in your own subject area only	C4 OTHER - C4 OTHER detentions are held centrally at lunchtime due to the vast majority of students travelling by bus. Subject detentions are not possible with split lunch arrangements.
Section 3, Page 10	..... A C6 exclusion is an exclusion from the PSR Room (C5).	The Principal may also choose to issue a C7 rather than a C6 – isolation to another academy. This carries the same points total as an FTE
Section 4, Page 12	...The Principal may also consider other alternatives to a Fixed Term Exclusion as listed in the Academy appendix	Issue of C7 – isolation to another academy. Student will attend another academy for a specific length of time and access their inclusion support room such as the equivalent PLC, Bridge or PSR for the duration of their exclusion. Students may be placed in ICE (Internal Community Exclusion). Students will work in supported isolation for the duration of their exclusion. This carries the same points total as an FTE The Vale Academy will usually work in partnership with Melior Academy.
